

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

**Change of Address -- Notice Required -- Penalty --**

The address of the licensee's place of business shall appear on the application for the license and on the license. The licensee shall promptly notify. The Superintendent in writing of a change of address. Failure to notify the Superintendent of a change of address within twenty days shall subject the licensee to a penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00)

**New Mexico RESIDENT Continuing Education -- Notification for agents, brokers, limited surety agents, solicitors, bail bond silicitors, and property bondsmen.-- Hours required annually. Title insurance licensees shall annually complete seven credit hours of approved courses covering title insurance. All other licensees shall annually complete 15 credit hours of approved courses covering some or all of the kinds of insurance for which they are licensed. Filing Fee is \$1.00 per credit, with a maximum of \$15.00. There is a fifty dollars (\$50.00) penalty for a licensee's failure to timely report continuing education credits.**

**Within sixty days of obtaining an agent license, the licensee shall become appointed by an authorized insurer to act as its agent; otherwise the license shall expire. A person shall not act as an agent of an insurer unless the person becomes appointed as an agent of the insurer. Within fifteen days from the date an agency contract is executed or the first insurance application from the person is accepted by the insurer, the insurer shall file a notice of appointment on a form approved by the superintendent. The agent or the insurer may terminate an appointment by notifying the superintendent and the other party in writing of the termination. If at any time all of the licensee's appointments have been terminated for a period of sixty days, the agent's license shall expire.**


